**Germination:** 14-21 days at 10-30°C Parsley (Petroselinum crispum) is a species of flowering plant that is native to the Mediterranean. Biennial often grown as an annual. Upright plant with curled dark green leaves.

Very decorative variety; often used as a garnish. Milder in flavour than Italian Parsley, it has a mild and bitter taste. Fast-growing. Can be used fresh or dried, raw or cooked and even medicinally. Can be grown in containers as long as it has access to the sun and has well-drained soil.

Sowing Depth: 3 mm
