

# Parsley



## Method:

Sow direct or raise seedlings

## When:

Winter, spring and autumn

## Hardiness / Life Cycle:

Hardy Biennial (usually grown as an Annual)

## Germination:

14-21 days at 10-30°C

Parsley (*Petroselinum crispum*) is a species of flowering plant that is native to the Mediterranean. Biennial often grown as an annual. Upright plant with curled dark green leaves.

- **Biennial**
- **Culinary herb**
- **Decorative variety**

Very decorative variety; often used as a garnish. Milder in flavour than Italian Parsley, it has a mild and bitter taste. Fast-growing. Can be used fresh or dried, raw or cooked and even medicinally. Can be grown in containers as long as it has access to the sun and has well-drained soil.
