

## Method:

Sow direct or raise seedlings

## When:

Spring and early summer (or after frost)

## Hardiness / Life Cycle:

Frost tender

## **Germination:**

5-10 days at 21-27°C Solanum lycopersicum, commonly known as a tomato plant is an edible often red berry. The species originated in western South America and Central America.

- Grown in temperate climates
- · Use in sauces, salads, and drinks
- · Source of umami flavor

Tomato plants typically grow to 1–3 meters (3–10 ft) in height. The vines have a weak stem that sprawls and typically needs support. The tomato is consumed in diverse ways, raw or cooked, in many dishes, sauces, salads, and drinks. They are a significant source of umami flavour.



Plant Spacing: 50 cm

Row Spacing: 60-70 cm

**Position:** Full sun, moist well drained soil

Days to Maturity/ Flowering: 70-80 days
